

What is the Parents Council all about and do:

Below is some information that is provided to all new Council Members, together with an extract from an information sheet provided to Principals and Council Members. We have left the original document on this website as a further point of reference.

By way of background, each State and Territory has, through the Bishops Commission for Catholic Education, an organisation such as the TCSPC established. Each organisation, including the TCSPC, is a member of a National body (Catholic School Parents Australia). We have been established to, amongst other things, support Tasmanian Catholic School parents, assist with Parent Engagement, and be a voice for Tasmanian Catholic School parents at a national level.

The current President of the TCSPC is Dr Perpetua (Pep) Turner, and there is an Executive Committee. There is also the wider Council, which is made up of individual school representatives such as yourself. There are 2 Council meetings each year to which all Council members are invited to attend (via on line or in person).
